304.3.A.2—Ineligible Student: Applying the Penalty

- 2) ~~If, however, the student's ineligibility was due to either the bylaw on mood-altering chemicals or non-school competition and the student has inadvertently been allowed to play by school officials, forfeiture will apply only to individual honors but not to team points, victories, or relays.~~

Rationale:

Use of an ineligible student in all circumstances should have the same application of penalties and suspensions. Inadvertently or unintentionally allowing an ineligible student with a chemical suspension or a non-school competition or training suspension should not be exceptions to the rule.
