**Location:** University of Minnesota Les Bolstad Golf Course, 2275 Larpenteur Ave W, St. Paul, MN, 55113

All spectators must park at the **MN State Fair Lot "Block 55" at 1680 Como Avenue** and ride a free shuttle to the State Meet.

### Parking

- **SPECTATOR PARKING & SHUTTLE SERVICE:** Spectator parking is free of charge and will be available on race day at the **MN State Fair Lot "Block 55" at 1680 Como Avenue, Falcon Heights** across the street from the MN State Fair Coliseum. [Shuttle Parking Lot Map](#)
- **Spectators should plan to arrive at the shuttle parking lot at least 60 minutes prior to the start of the race(s) they wish to see.**
- Shuttle service to and from the golf course and the parking lot will be provided from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm on race day. The shuttle pickup and drop off points will be posted with large "Shuttle Stop" signs.
- **Spectator Parking is NOT ALLOWED on site at the golf course and there is limited street parking near the venue.** Security will be at each entry point of campus and will only admit buses and team vans with official parking passes, and vehicles with a current disability permit or license plates.

## Spectator Policies and Information

- Guests should stay home if they are sick or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19
- Spectators are not permitted to bring cameras into League State Tournament venues. This includes both still and video cameras.
- Camera tri-pods/mono-pods and “selfie sticks” are NOT allowed.
- No beverages, food or noisemakers will be allowed to be brought into the facility.
- No balloons, laser pointers, noisemakers, air-horns, horns, drums, or whistles will be allowed in the facility.
- No weapons of any kind including licensed concealed carry weapons, knives, etc.
- No signs or banners may be hung in the facility. Hand-held signs allowed (can be held by one person)
- No drones allowed.
- SPECTATORS ON COURSE: Instruct spectators from your school to stay behind the fences in order that all runners will have a fair opportunity to do their best. Spectator interference may result in the disqualification of a team or individual.
